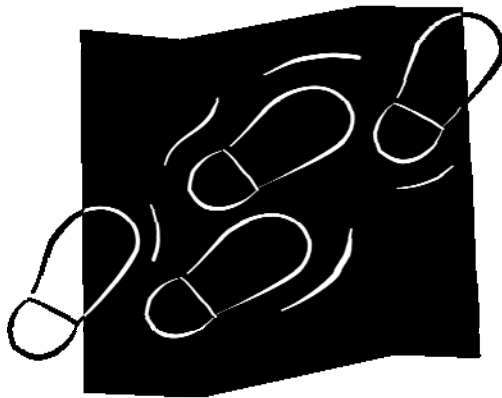

**How will you get out
in a fire?
Plan your escape now!**



- Draw a map of your home.
- Have **two** ways out of each room.
- Choose an outdoor meeting place in the front yard away from the house.
- Practice and discuss your escape plan with your whole family.
- Write the emergency number at the top of your escape plan and put it on the refrigerator for reference.



**Always Be
PREPARED!**

- Check your smoke alarms monthly and change the batteries once a year when the time changes.
- Replace your smoke alarms every ten years.
- Practice your escape plan twice a year with the sound of the smoke alarm.
- Make sure everyone in your family recognizes the sound of the smoke alarm and knows what to do and where to meet.
- Make sure that your windows open and close easily in case of emergency.
- Keep exit ways clear of any objects for a fast escape.

Remember...

- **DO** practice your escape plan.
- **DO** close doors behind you when you practice and during a real fire.
- **DO** crawl low under smoke.
- **DO** get out fast and go to a neighbor's house to call 911.
- **DON'T** disconnect or take batteries out of a smoke alarm.
- **DON'T** stop for anything during your escape.
- **DON'T** ever go back into a burning building. This is the job of firefighters.
