Be Smart—Sign Up for Smart911

Nobody plans to call 9-1-1, but a little planning can make a big difference if there is a fire, medical or police emergency such as a missing child. Snohomish County residents can sign up for Smart911, a **FREE SERVICE** that helps you provide information that may help emergency responders save valuable seconds in an emergency.

Sign up at www.smart911.com to let us know before you need help:

- Are there medical conditions responders should know about?
- For seniors and the elderly—is there information about caretakers?
- Do you or a household member have disabilities that would make evacuation difficult?
- If you call 9-1-1 from your cell phone—what address is associated with that number?
- Provide your child's photo and description in case of an emergency.

You control what information you provide.

Your information is secure, confidential and only shared with responders when you call 9-1-1.
