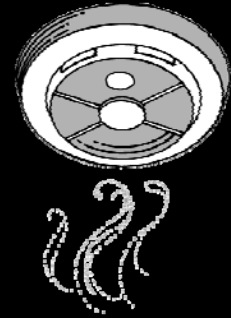


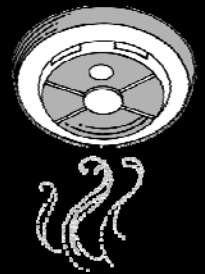

Replace smoke alarms every 10 years.

Smoke Alarm Safety Tips



- Most smoke alarms should be replaced every 10 years.
- Make sure you know how old all the smoke alarms are in your home.
- To find out how old a smoke alarm is, look at the date of manufacture on the back of the alarm.
- Place alarm back on the wall if it is less than 10 years old.
- Did you know the smoke alarm sensor becomes less effective after 10 years?

Remember, if a smoke alarm sounds, get out and stay out! Go to your outdoor meeting place and call 911 from a safe place.
